

# Appendix A: Board Selection of a State Director

After the August meeting in the year of selection, the Board of Directors will solicit applications from candidates in their districts. These applications should include; a letter of interest, philosophy of leadership of the organization, a resume of career achievements, three letters of recommendation from other troupe directors in their district, and a letter of approval from their current administration (if an employee of a school).

The Board of Directors will return with the applications to the October meeting for perusal by the "Nomination Committee".

The "Nomination Committee" will bring forward no more than three(3) candidates and no less than one for board approval at the January/February meeting of the Board of directors.

The State Board of Directors will vote for final election of the State Director according to Article III, Section B, Number 3 of the Florida Thespians By Laws.

The State Director-Elect will be notified after the State festival.

The State Director-Elect will assume their duties at the August Meeting of the Board of Directors in the following year of the current state director's term to ensure a two year shadowing process.
